APPLICATION PREREQUISITES	Applicants should have obtained at least 180 ECTS (for master level), 120 ECTS (for bachelor level 3rd year), 60 ECTS (for bachelor level 2nd year)
NOMINATION DEADLINES	1st semester or full academic year : 1st May 2023 2nd semester : 1st November 2023
APPLICATION DEADLINES	1st semester or full academic year : 30 May 2023 2nd semester : 30 November 2023 Once you are accepted as an exchange student, you will receive a letter of admission, allowing you to register as an exchange student. Late applications can be refused.

NOMINATION AND APPLICATION

Step 1 – Your home university should send your nomination via email to our International Office : laurence.coste@st-etienne.archi.fr before the deadline, mentioning your name, email address, registration level, field of study and design studio choice (for master level), and exchange period.
Step 2 – complete the application procedure via email.
Please do not forget to upload the supporting documents :
- Application letter in which you explain the choice of our programme (field of study and design studio choice if possible).
- Proof of enrolment at the home institution – from which your current level of study can be deducted (ECTS).
- Proof of language qualification (B2 level).
- Photocopy of the identity page of your passport or identity card. All documents should be uploaded in pdf-format.
Incomplete applications will not be processed. Only applications via email will be considered.
